2] Events & Format

The Championship is an Individual Event and consists of Men's Singles, Men's Doubles, Women's Singles, Women's Doubles and Mixed Doubles in the following format:

BWF Rules and Regulations will be applied using the Grand Prix competition format.

There will be qualifying rounds in all the Events depending on the number of Entries received.

The Qualifying Rounds will be played on the 12th April 2010 with round of maximum 32 qualification in Singles and 16 in Doubles.

5] **Status & Prize Money:**

The Event is categorised under BWF level 3 (GOLD) with World Ranking Points. It carries total Prize Money of US\$150,000.00.

Distributions of Prize Money are in accordance with BWF regulations. Medals will be for all Winners, Runners-up and 2 losing Semi-Finalists.

6] **Entries:**

Each participating country will be entitled to the following number of entries:-

- 6.1 Men's Singles : maximum 6 entries
- 6.2 Women's Singles : maximum 6 entries
- 6.3 Men's Doubles : maximum 3 pairs
- 6.4 Women's Doubles : maximum 3 pairs
- 6.5 Mixed Doubles : maximum 4 pairs

All entries must be submitted by fax or emailed directly to the Confederation's secretariat at events@badmintonasia.org or by fax at +603-9284 3251 before the closing date as stipulated below. Entries must be endorsed by the National Badminton Association. **Submission of entries will only be accepted by using the attached entry forms. Host Association is qualified to add 2 additional entries in each events.**

All entries must be in accordance with the respective National Rankings.

Key dates

- 1. The closing date for submission of entries is on 15th March 2010.**
- 2. Selected Main and Qualify by BWF WR dated 18th March 2010.**
- 3. Seedings will be done base on BWF Rankings dated 1st April 2010.**
- 4. The Draws will be conducted by Tournament Software on 6th April 2010 by BAC.**

A Committee of Management comprising officials from the Confederation, Badminton Association of India and the Championships Referees to ensure the smooth running of the Championships. **All decisions taken by the Committee of Management of the Championships shall be final.**

7] Eligibility:

All participants should NOT be below 14 years old.

8] Withdrawals:

Any withdrawals / substitutions must be informed to the Confederation's secretariat before the commencement of the Draw on **6th April 2010.**

As per BWF's regulations, penalty charges of US\$250 per entry will be imposed for any withdrawals without any valid reasons or documentations after **6th April 2010 by BAC.**

9] Doping Test:

Dope testing will be conducted as per WADA regulations.

Please note **Competition Regulation Appendix 3 “Anti Doping Regulations”** in the BWF Statutes.

10] On-Court Doctor:

There will be on-court doctors on duty throughout the competition at the tournament venue.

11] Clothing & Advertising:

Clothing & advertising are in accordance with BWF Statutes.

12] Equipment:

Yonex-Sunrise is the Official Equipment Supplier.

13] Subsidies:

The Confederation will assist needy participating teams with limited airfare subsidies and the Host Organizer will provide Food and Accommodation for 6 persons (at least 4 are players) from each country for a maximum of 7 nights.
