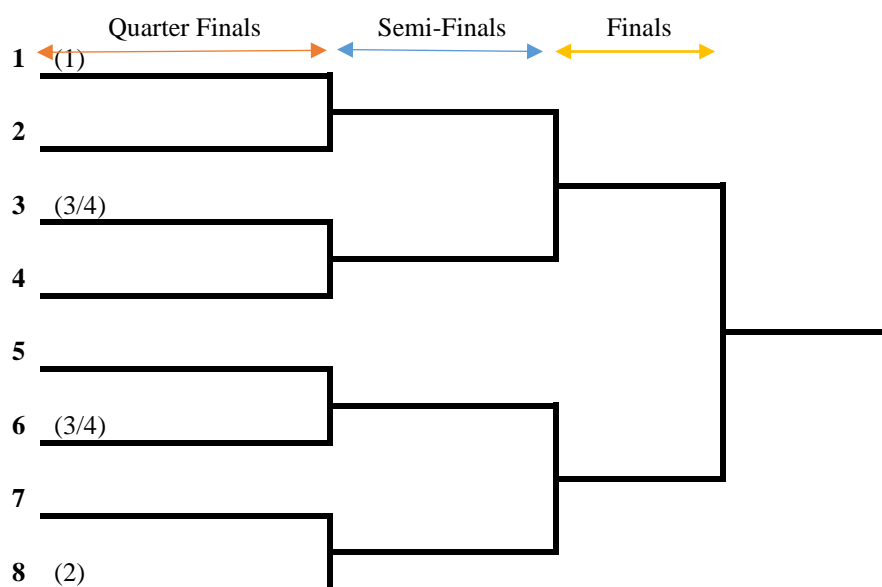

<p>Responsibility, Withdrawals & Penalties</p>	<p>Every Member Association participating in the Badminton Asia Mixed Team Championship shall be responsible for all expenses its players and officials incurred, including travel, hotel accommodation, and other expenses.</p> <p>Withdrawal Penalty</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. If a Member Association withdraws a team from the Championship after the entry dateline (By team) before the draw, for any reason whatsoever, such a Member Association shall automatically be penalized with an administrative fine of US\$ 1,000.00 per team. 2. If a Member Association withdraws a team from the Championship after the draw for any reason whatsoever, the Member Association shall automatically be penalized with an administrative fine of US\$ 3,000.00 per team. 3. If a Member Association fails to show up at the Championship (No Show) for any reason whatsoever, the Member Association shall automatically be penalized with an administrative fine of US\$ 5,000.00 per team. 4. If a team of a Member Association arrives late or departs early for any reason whatsoever and affects the team's ability to play or complete their scheduled matches or ties, such Member Association shall be penalized by an administrative fine of US\$ 1,500.00 per team. 5. If a medal-winning team of the Member Association is not present at the medal ceremony for any reason whatsoever, the Member Association shall be penalized by an administrative fine of US\$ 1,500.00 per team.

Constitution of Ties & Teams	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Each tie shall be decided by the results of Two (2) singles and three (3) doubles matches. In the Group stage, all five (5) matches of each tie shall be played. In the Knock out stage, each tie shall be stopped when the tie is decided. No player shall play more than two matches in a tie. Each team must nominate a minimum of Four (4) Players for each tie. (2 Men and 2 Women) 																																																							
Format of Play	<p>Badminton Asia Mixed Team Championship shall be played in two stages:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Group Stage (Qualifying Stage): Round Robin within groups. 1.1 Knock Out Stage Draw's Methodology

The Teams will be dealt with as follows:

- I. Seeds 1 and 2 will be placed in Positions 1 and 8
- II. Seeds 3 and 4 will be drawn into Positions 3 and 6
- III. The remaining teams will be drawn into Positions 2, 4, 5, and 7 accordingly.
- IV. Teams from the same group will not be drawn to play in the First Round (Quarter Finals) in the knockout draw.

* The teams from the same group shall not be drawn to meet in the first round in the knockout stage.

** The Final position (top of each group) after the completion of the Group Stage will be used to determine new seeding position for Knock Out Stage, the top of each group will be ranked by (Team Strength) as per the seeding ranking date stated in the Key Dates.

Important Note:

- Badminton Asia reserves the right to determine the number of groups and the size of each group for the Group Stage to be decided based on the number of participating teams.
- Badminton Asia reserves the right to determine the size of the draw for the Knockout Stage accordingly based on the number of participating teams.
- Badminton Asia reserves the right for final decision for any matter related to the Championship.

Seeding	<p>Seeding will be done by Badminton Asia based on BWF World rankings. The date of the world ranking to be used will be in accordance with the dates stipulated in the Timeline below.</p> <p>Total Ranking Points of each event will be calculated based on the highest ranked Men’s Singles, Women’s Singles, Men’s Doubles, Women’s Doubles, and Mixed Doubles from each member association, and seeding will be calculated by comparing the total ranking points of each member to determine the overall strength of the team. Clothing & Advertising	<p>Clothing and advertising will be permitted in accordance with the competition regulations of the Badminton World Federation. (GCR 20 - 24)</p> <p>On player clothing, the player's name, shall be identical to the name registered as the Last Name (or an abbreviation thereof) in the BWF Player database, and if desired, the initial(s) of the name(s) registered as the First Name in the BWF Player database. The Last Name is defined as the family name, surname, or similar name under the respective naming protocol of the Member country (GCR 23.3).</p> <p><u>MANDATORY CLOTHING REGULATIONS</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The Player Name and Country/Team Name is MANDATORY from the first day of the event. 2. From Day 1, all participating teams must wear team colors. That is, each player must wear the same color and design of shirts and shorts (or equivalent articles of clothing) throughout a tie. 3. From Day 1, opposing players must wear clothing of significantly different colors.
